Field of activity:

The capabilities of the DGG, the association of Freight Villages in Germany, include the development of contact potentials and the share of experiences between the single FV locations in German and European FV.



The main activity fields are:

- Intermodal traffic (implementation of intermodal relations between Freight Villages)

- Development of sustainable schemes for independent Freight Village operators

Foundation and development:



In 1993 the DGG was founded as a national association for all developing companies of Freight Villages in Germany. Since 1998 the ISL and LUB-Consulting have taken over the management of the DGG and put in each case a manager. Head office of the DGG is Bremen. 23 FV locations as well as a leading logistics real estate developer count to the members of the DGG currently.
